




This collaborative effort not only achieved unprecedented success but also became Pakistan's first action series to grace the airwaves of **PTV**.







7 out of 10 top Pakistani Drama Serials were of Geo Ent. in September 2013. (Aanalyzed on average GRPs per episode basis).

Almost all drama serials of Geo Ent. in 8-9pm slot are performing good and mostly remain on no.1 position except 'Numm' which airs on Saturday.

Mera Sultan and CID give tough time to our competitor channels. Both dramas are leading in respective time-slots. Kahani is consistently beating Hum Tv.

See Ent. currently has best dramas in Prime Time slot (8:00-09:00pm) with highest viewership. It leads in 5/7 days a week in the slot with substantial margin of ratings Aasmano Pe Likha has broken all records of the industry and got highest GRPs in irst 4 episodes. Both Geo Ent. and Kahani are giving tough time to competitor hannels including Hum TV and ARY. Their Sales revenue and ratings are declining.



OVERHEADS

Minimized Overheads:

We have minimized the overheads. Our big achievement is that we have launched a whole new channel successfully without having additional overheads. Currently, we are in the process of consolidating staff on one location at Clifton.

REVENUES AND SALES TARGETS

Revenues

Geo Kahani is generating Rs.6~7 Crores per month. We have had highest sales record in October 2013 i.e. Rs.31 Crores (Geo Ent, 24Cr. + Geo Kahani, 7 Cr)

Business Targets

Business targets have been established and sales team has been formed. The overall targets for Geo Ent. and Geo Kahani are Rs.220m and Rs.110~112 millions per month respectively. These targets will be implemented wef January 2014.


Geo Kahani in Top 3 Ranking:

Geo Kahani was launched in May 2013 and within few months it has become an A-Category channel. The channel maintains its position on No.2~3 in primetime. It has its own look and feel and the brand has been established over the period of time.
